

Kumon Study Over Vacation

Dear Parents,

While on vacation, it is especially crucial that you help your children to remember a few of the Kumon fundamentals. With that in mind, I would like to remind you of a few items:

TIME - It is very important that your child records accurate completion times. Whether using a clock (with starting and ending times) OR a stop watch, it is crucial that the time is recorded, so that we can factor this in when determining whether or not your child needs repetition.

DAILY WORK - Provided you have requested it with enough advanced notice, your child will receive an assignment for every day of his or her vacation. Please do your best to ensure that your child does his/her work on a daily basis. Too much work on one day or two many days without doing Kumon can be a detriment to your child's progress. (If your child happens to miss a day or two, it is important that you do the assignments in the ORDER they were assigned.)

REPETITION - Your child may see some worksheets more than once over vacation. Please ensure that your child does all work as assigned, in the order it is assigned.

HOME-GRADING - If you are not already home-grading your child's Kumon worksheets, you need to do it while on vacation. By correcting your child's mistakes immediately after he/she makes them, you prevent the errors from being repeated. By identifying a problem early-on, you maximize the potential to eliminate the error in the future. (A handout on home-grading has been provided along with answer books for the level your child is studying.)

By following these guidelines, you and your children will get the most benefit out of their Kumon study. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask.
